# CAO Report – Sherry Garbe

### Council Meeting Highlights (August 17, 2020):

There has been a delay on the sewer project on 51 Ave. during excavation the contractors found contaminated soil. We are working with Alberta Environment, the contractor, the source of the contamination and an environmental firm so that the project can resume. There is no danger to the residents of Holden.

### Resident Questions:

Q: What is the length of the CAO's contract?

A: 5 years ending in October 2022

Q: Is there a way to keep up on what is happening in Holden?

## PARAGON THEATRE REOPEN – MOVIES

Beaverhill Players/Paragon Theatre are planning to reopen the Paragon Theatre for movies starting July 18, 2020.

Both the Theatre volunteers and Patrons are expected to follow all the current Alberta Health guidelines for COVID-19.

These include:

- Hand Sanitization upon entry & exit to Theatre
- Complete Health Quiz upon entry
- Provide Contact name & number for contact tracing, kept only by Theatre & destroyed after 14 days
- Masks by Patrons are required for Patrons entering and moving within Theatre. Masks can be removed while seated.
- Seating is only in designated places to meet physical distance.
- Recommend social distancing while moving within the Theatre
- Volunteers will be wearing masks & gloves
- Theatre cleaning of public contact points between shows.
- Limited restroom use


