#### CAUTION

Please be aware that you are entering the library at your own risk. We are taking precautions to help make the library a safe place. Please be respectful and patient as staff navigate the changes implemented.



#### LIMITED HOURS

Libraries will reopen for the public with limited hours. BY APPOINTMENTS ONLY Visits are only 20 minutes long

Tuesday - 1:00 pm - 5:30 pm



#### LIMITED CAPACITY

Occupancy will be limited to 2 people in order to maintain social distancing. We ask that you limit your party to 2 people per visit.

No Children under the age of 15 will be allowed



#### PHONE FOR APPOINTMENTS

Please phone on Tuesday before 12:00 p.m to book and appointment. If you don't make an appointment you may have to wait for a while.



#### MASKS & SANITIZE HANDS

It is mandatory to wear your mask in the library. The Library will have masks for you if you forget yours. If you cannot wear a mask we ask that you use our curbside pick-up service to borrow books and materials.



#### LIMITED COMPUTER USE

Only 1 computer time is limited to 30 minutes per session. Computers will be sanitized and cleaned after every use. Booking times are available.



#### SEATING

All seating have been set for social distancing.



#### RETURNING ITEMS

If you are just returning your Items. Please use the Bin between the doors to return your items. If you have an appointment you can bring your items into the library. They will be isolated for 96 hours before, cheked-in, and re-shelved.

# HOLDEN LEGION BRANCH NO. 56 REMEMBRANCE DAY CEREMONEY AT THE CENOTAPH 11 NOVEMBER, 2020 AT 11:00 A.M.

The importance of a live ceremony honouring our veterans and their sacrifices is considered paramount by the Legion especially during this 75th Anniversary of the end of the Second World War.

Guidelines for a safe ceremony have been issued by Dominion Command in Ottawa, and working within the restrictions imposed, the ceremony will be conducted as follows:

- 1. The legion will not be open to the public.
- 2. Only the Colour Party will march from the Legion to the Cenotaph.
- 3. Only 4 wreaths will be laid during the ceremony ie The Federal, Provincial, Holden Legion and Ladies Auxiliary wreaths.
- 4. The names of businesses, groups and individuals who sponsor wreaths will be
- 5. acknowledged and thanked during the ceremony. They will be asked to lay their wreaths AFTER the ceremony is concluded and attendees have dispersed.
- 6. There will be NO theatre programme.
- 7. There will be NO Pot-Luck lunch.

In order for us all to be safe, we request that masks be worn and physical distance maintained. We hope that by next year we will be able to return to our traditional Remembrance Day Ceremony. In these difficult and confusing times, we would like to thank everyone for their continuing support.






