

We are working with local businesses and community organizations to build a school that embraces our rural culture, providing opportunities for students to develop good citizenship and leadership skills.




2020 Winter Reading Program January to February 28,2021

The winter reading program requires a minimum amount of allotted reading hours for participants to be eligible for entry into the grand prize draw.



What It Is: The Community Rereading Program provides an opportunity for individuals to share their favourite book with fellow readers, which in turn works to build a more connected and engaged community!


How It Works:

<u>Step 3:</u> The libraries will fill the requests, and make arrangements to drop off or pick up the book that was recommended for you.


<u>Step 4:</u> Read your book, and enjoy learning more about your community members through their literary choices! (Don't forget to return the book when you are through!)




