## Village News and Notes

Dear Holden Residents,

The appearance of our Village is very important to us and we want to send a friendly reminder that large items are **NOT** to be placed around, near, or in the garbage bins. Claystone will **NOT** empty any bin that has an item leaning on it, laying close to it, or if the lid doesn't shut completely.

Claystone puts on a "Large Item collection" twice a year to aid Village residents in removal of their larger items. Residents are always welcome to take any large items to the Ryley dump free of charge should they not want to wait or are unable to wait for the next Large Item Collection.

As per the Village of Holden's Community Standards Bylaw, the residents are to uphold the prevention of any and all nuisances (Clause 4.1) which include unsightly premises which is defined as:

2.17 **"Unsightly Premises"** shall mean any structure or property located within the Village that in the opinion of the Inspector, Peace Officer or Chief Administrative Officer, is unsightly to such an extent as to detrimentally affect the amenities, use, value or enjoyment of the surrounding lands in reasonable proximity to the unsightly premises, or is otherwise detrimental to the surrounding area or in an unsightly condition as defined in the *Municipal Government Act*.

Unsightly premises consists of "garbage" as defined as:

2.8 **"Garbage"** means any rubbish, refuse, papers, packages, containers, bottles, cans, manure, animal or human excrement or sewage or the whole or a part of an animal carcass, dirt, soil, gravel, rocks, sod, petroleum products, hazardous materials, disassembled equipment or machinery, broken household furnishings or appliances, boxes, cartons, discarded fabrics, any materials composed of organic matter which is or may become decomposed, including the by-products from the preparation, consumption or storage of food.

The Village is NOT responsible to pick up or dispose of large items left around the village throughout the year. Please help us keep the Village of Holden clean and attractive.



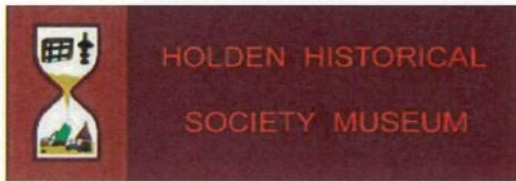
