Please remember it is Summer time. Children are outside playing.

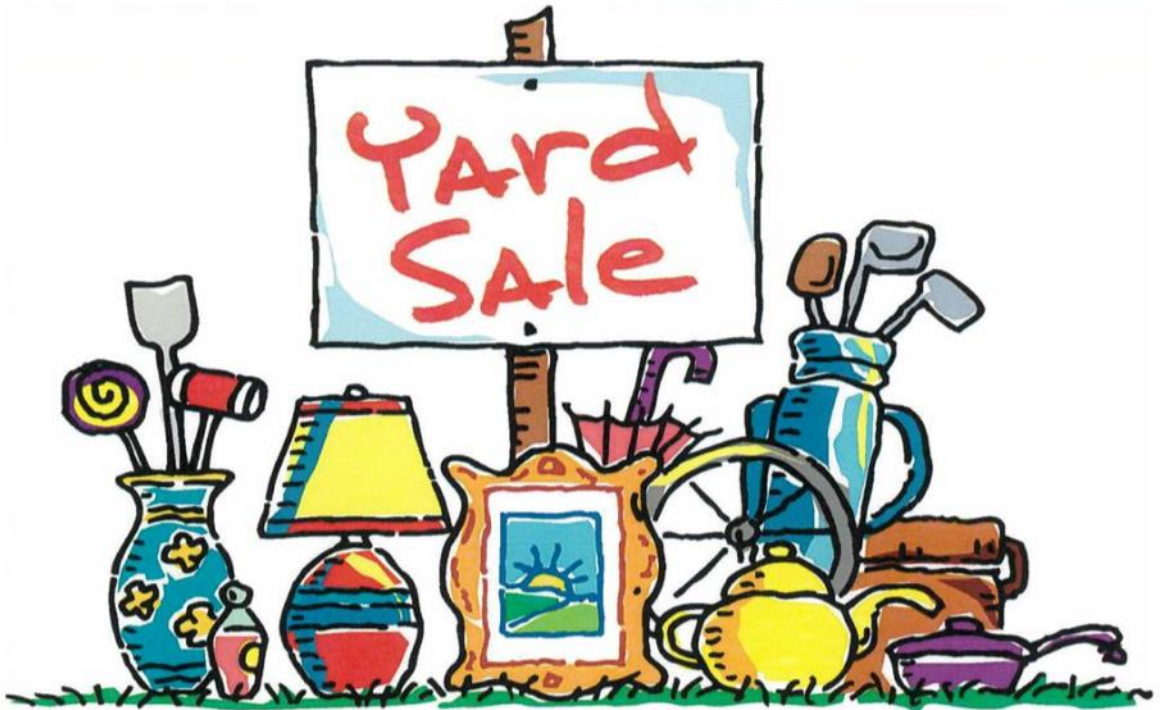
When going through town, keep this in mind and maintain a reasonable speed.

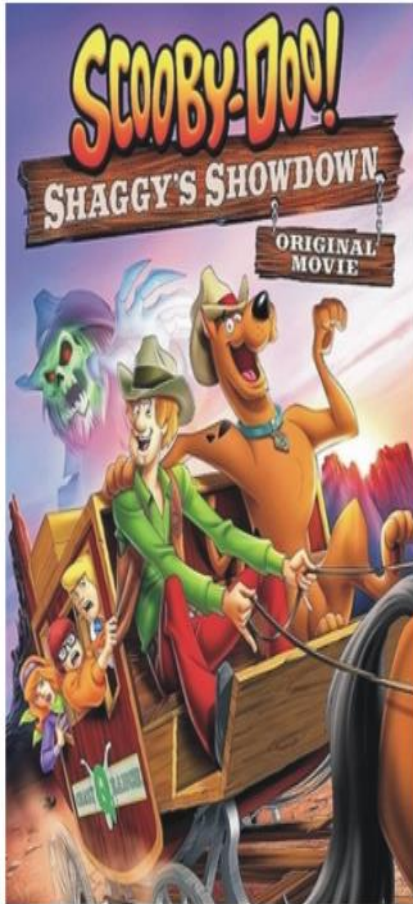

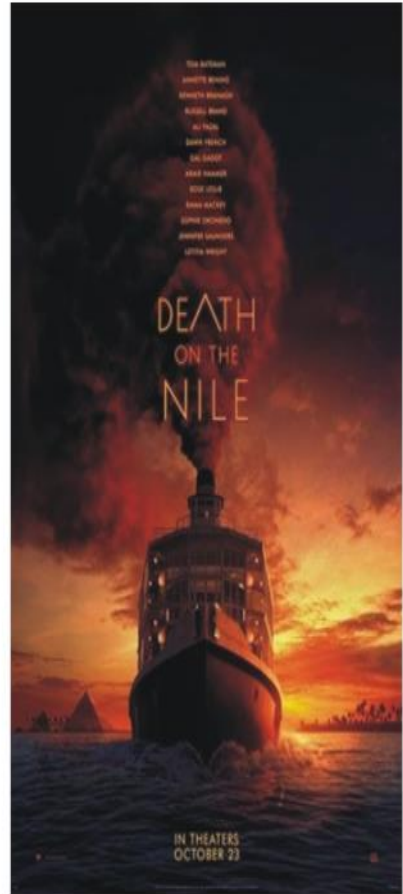

FOOD BANK

The Viking/Holden and Area Food Bank provides food hampers to residents in the eastern portion of Beaver County, including the communities of Kinsella, Viking, Bruce and Holden.

How it works:

- Individuals requiring a hamper contact VBFCSS at 780-336-4024 **no later than 4 p.m. Tuesday.**
- VBFCSS staff will conduct a brief assessment with applicant to identify needs and any potential additional supports which may be helpful.
- Hampers are put together by a team of volunteers and made available for pick up at the Food Bank (4924 53 Ave., Viking) between 10:30-11:30 a.m. on Wednesdays. (Very limited drop-off options may be available).

No more than one hamper permitted per individual/family per month.

***Food bank donations can be dropped off at the Holden FCSS office anytime! Most needed items include peanut butter, juice, and oatmeal. Thank you for your kindness! ***

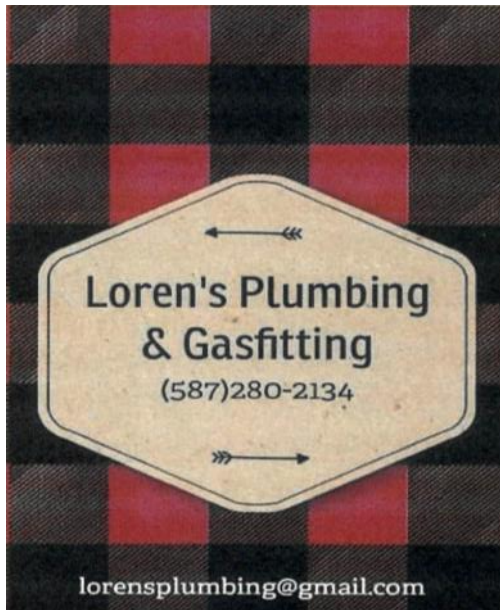
