- Hampers are put together by a team of volunteers and made available for pick up at the Food Bank (4924 53 Ave., Viking) between 10:30-11:30 a.m. on Wednesdays. (Very limited drop-off options may be available).

No more than one hamper permitted per individual/family per month.

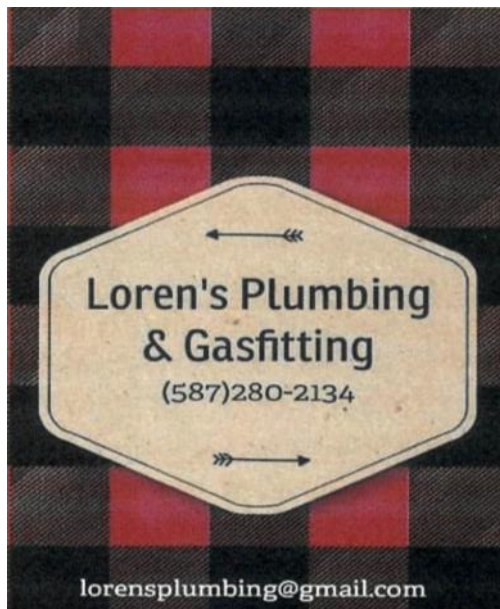
