

Windows and doors Replace your doors, windows or sliding glass doors with ENERGY STAR® certified models.	Up to \$5,000
<u>Thermostat</u> Add a smart thermostat to help improve your comfort and save money on your energy bill (must be combined with another energy efficiency retrofit).	Up to \$50
Space and water heating Clarified Installation Requirements June 2022 Make the switch to more energy-efficient space heating or water heating equipment to save on your utility bill and reduce your carbon footprint.	Up to \$5,000
Renewable energy Install a solar photovoltaic system to convert sunlight energy into electricity.	Up to \$5,000


