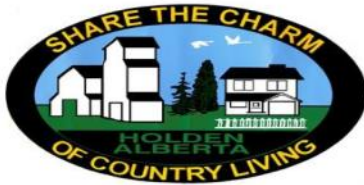

Notice to the General Public of the Village of Holden – Proposed Tax Rate Bylaw No. 3-2023

The Proposed Tax Rate Bylaw No. 3-2023 is to meet the requirements of the Alberta Municipal Government Act, Section 354, whereby, a municipal Council must pass a property tax bylaw annually.

The purpose of the bylaw is to authorize Council to impose a tax in respect of property within the municipality to raise revenue to be used toward the payment of, expenditures and transfers set out in the budget of the municipality, and to collect the education and lodge requisitions as per Section 359.1(1) and Section 326(1)(v).

If any resident of Holden has concerns with the proposed bylaw, they may send a notice of their concerns to the Village Office, Box 357, Holden, AB T0B 2C0. The notice must outline the concern(s) that the individual has with the proposed bylaw and the reason why they are concerned.

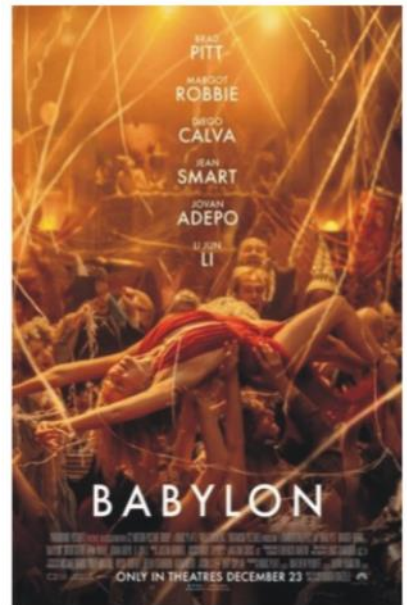

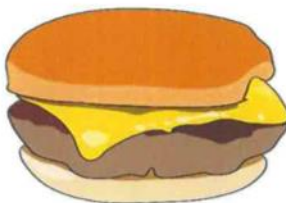

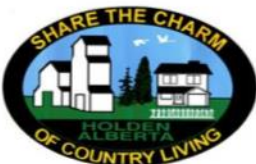




LARGE ITEM PICK-UP

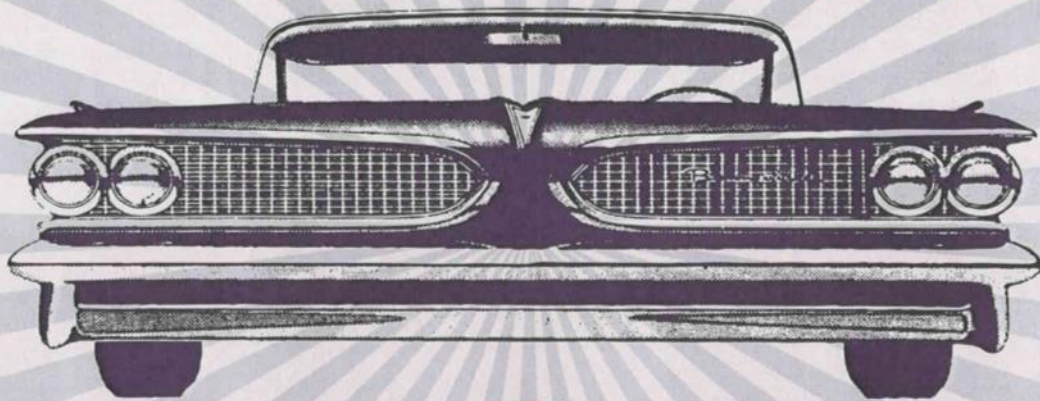
