Notice to the General Public of the Village of Holden – Proposed Animal Control Bylaw No. 4-2023

The Animal Control Bylaw No. 4-2023 is to meet the requirements of the Alberta Municipal Government Act, Section 354, whereby, a municipal Council may pass an Animal Control Bylaw.

The purpose of the bylaw is for Council to authorize the Chief Administrative Officer or their designates to enforce Animal Control under the guidance of the criteria that Council has placed in the bylaw within the boundaries of the municipality.

If any resident of Holden has concerns with the proposed bylaw, they may send a notice of their concerns to the Village Office, Box 357, Holden, AB T0B 2C0. The notice must outline the concern(s) that the individual has with the proposed bylaw and the reason why they are concerned.






