BYLAW NO. 1-2016

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLDEN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL ADDRESS SYSTEM

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and as amended, provides that a municipality may assign a means of identification to buildings or parcels of land and may require an owner or occupant of a building or parcel of land to display the identification in a certain manner; and

WHEREAS Council has deemed it necessary update the requirements of the municipal address system which can be utilized by emergency service providers;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Holden, in regular meeting, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

CITATION

This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Municipal Address Bylaw".

DEFINITIONS

- 1. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "Bylaw Enforcement Officer" means a Bylaw Enforcement Officer or Community Peace Officer appointed or contracted by the Village of Holden.
 - b. "Owner" means:
 - i. in the case of land, any person who is registered under the Land Titles Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter L-4, and as amended, as the owner of a parcel of land, or
 - ii. in the case of property other than land, any person who is in lawful possession thereof.
 - c. "Parcel of Land" means the aggregate of the one or more areas of land described in a certificate of title, or described in a certificate of title by reference to a plan filed or registered in a land titles office.
 - d. "Structure" means a dwelling or any building that requires a development permit.
 - e. "Village" means Village of Holden.
 - f. "Violation Ticket" means a ticket as defined in the Provincial Offences Procedure Act, as amended.

SIGNAGE REQUIREMENTS

1. All parcels of land in the Village, which are occupied by a structure, shall be assigned an address by the Village, according to Bylaw No. 8-1962.

- 2. Every person who, at the time of the passing of this Bylaw, is the owner of a parcel of land, to which a structure is affixed, shall be required to have property numbers shown on or near front entrances.
- 3. Numbers shall be:
 - a. at least 4 inches in height;
 - b. of a contrasting color from the background where they are affixed; and
 - c. prominently displayed so that they are visible, un-obstructed, and easily read from the street or avenue.
- 4. It is the responsibility of all property owners to ascertain the proper address numbers for their parcel of land by contacting the Village office.

PENALTIES

- 1. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this Bylaw or not complying with its requirements is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a minimum fine of \$50.00 (fifty dollars), exclusive of costs.
- 2. A Bylaw Enforcement Officer may issue a Violation Ticket to any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw.

EFFECTIVE DATE

- 1. This Bylaw takes effect as of the date of third and final reading; and upon such final passage Bylaw No. 3-2005 shall be repealed.
- 2. Sections 6 and 8 of Bylaw 8-1962 also remain as repealed.
