

2023 Fall Large Item Collection Program

Information and Schedule

Monday, October 30 to Thursday, November 2–Village of Holden

No curbside collection. Bring your items to the large bins located:

- ✓ Empty lot at 5024-50 St
- Gazebo Park entrance located on 51 St.
- Beside Beaver County's 4yd bins on 48 St.
- ✓ West side of Public Works shop at 4920-48 Ave

This collection program is provided at no-charge to regional municipal residents twice a year. If you are a Holden, Ryley or Bruce resident who needs help getting large items to one of the central collection bins, please reach out to our Collections Department (number below) for assistance.

Fridges, freezers and water coolers are acceptable, however there is a \$25 charge for the Freon removal. Payment for Freon removal can be made at either your local Town/Village Office. Once payment has been made, a sticker will be provided that needs to be placed either on the front or side of the appliance.

In the past, regular garbage was placed out for collection through this program, instead of just large items such as sofas and washing machines. Please remember that if your item fits in the waste collection bin in your alley, you should put it in there for disposal. This program is for large items.

Acceptable Items:

These items are considered acceptable for this program:

- mattresses
- sofas and recliners
- desks, chairs and tables
- white goods and appliances
- tires
- propane tanks



Unacceptable Items:

The following items are not accepted as part of the Large Item Pick-Up Program:

- Grass clippings, trees, tree branches can be taken to any of the Transfer Stations or the public drop off area at Ryley
- Large chunks of cement/concrete must be taken to the landfill
- Bags of garbage can be placed in your neighbourhood waste bin
- Small items that would fit in your neighbourhood waste bin
- Electronic waste can be taken to Viking, Tofield, Lindbrook and Ryley Transfer Stations yearround
