VILLAGE OF HOLDEN NOTICE

Re: Snow Removal

Bylaw No. 4-2011 states that:

- Snow must be cleared from sidewalks within 48 hours of snowfall This means any public sidewalk adjacent to your property (front or side).
- Snow removed from sidewalks & driveways must NOT be placed on the roadway [There are a few exceptions to this, where Main Street business have no access to a boulevard or yard space.] But other than that.....
- Please Do Not shovel, push, blow, pile, or spread snow on the roads or alleys, either from your yard, driveway, sidewalks, or the adjacent roadways.
- If you are removing a large quantity of snow, and cannot place it on your property, use the same "push-sites" that the grader uses, and pile the snow there.
- The grader makes every attempt to keep driveways clear & not block them in, but it is impossible for the grader to avoid blocking narrow walkways.
- If you see the grader working on your street, please move your vehicle.
- Quantity of Snow = Degree of Challenge! Be patient and helpful... This is Winter in Canada!


