

**BY-LAW NO. 2-2024**

**A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLDEN  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
TO AUTHORIZE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS TO USE  
FLASHING GREEN LIGHTS IN THEIR PERSONAL VEHICLES**

**Whereas**, by authority of Section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of the Village of Holden, duly assembled, enacts the following:


1. A full-time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in their personal vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
2. No person other than a full-time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
3. Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit a full-time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the Alberta Traffic Act, any other Act, the regulations or municipal bylaw.

This bylaw shall come into effect upon final reading.

**READ A SECOND TIME** this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2024.

**READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME** this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2024.
