BY-LAW NO. 2-2024

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLDEN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS TO USE FLASHING GREEN LIGHTS IN THEIR PERSONAL VEHICLES

Whereas, by authority of Section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of the Village of Holden, duly assembled, enacts the following:

- A full- time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in their personal vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
- 2. No person other than a full-time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit a fulltime or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the Alberta Traffic Act, any other Act, the regulations or municipal bylaw.

This bylaw shall come into effect upon final reading.
