Chip Seal Construction Update

To receive 2nd chip seal:

- TWP RD 490 BETWEEN RGE RD 124 & RGE RD 120
- RGE RD 120 BETWEEN TWP RD 490 & NORTH OF THE COLONY ENTERANCE
- 49 STREET IN HOLDEN
- RGE RD 161A BETWEEN HWY 14 & HWY 855

There will be many loose rocks after the second chip seal layer is applied and speed limits will continue to be reduced on these roads until the final sweep is complete.

During this construction period, parts of the road may be closed for crew safety. Please use alternative routes; detours will be clearly marked. If you must drive through construction zones, proceed with caution (local traffic only). Beaver County's goal is to provide a healthy, injury free work environment for all employees, contractors, visitors and general public. Already this year we have had people exceeding the posted speed limit through our construction zones, endangering staff, contractors and the public.

There are potential hazards to the public and vehicles during the construction process. This can include heavy machinery, dust or mud, road material such as gravel, asphalt coatings and rock chips.

We apologize for the inconvenience that road maintenance and upgrading causes, but the same roads that receive the most traffic also need the most maintenance. Claystone Waste Ltd. is offering compost, free of charge, to residents of Beaver County, Villages of Holden and Ryley, and the Towns of Tofield and Viking.

Claystone has set aside two bins of finished, lab-tested Category A compost for residents to pick up starting Friday, Aug. 2, 2024, from the Ryley Transfer Station.

- Residents will be required to load their own compost by hand – no mechanical equipment is permitted.
- Residents will also need to bring their own containers, shovels, and gloves.
- Claystone also recommends a face mask and protective eyewear, particularly on windy days, and a tarp to cover any open loads.

Although we have two large bins of compost for residents, we do expect it to go quite quickly, so we encourage residents to come out as soon as is convenient for them to get the compost for their needs. If they need larger amounts, or if anyone is interested in compost for commercial use, they are welcome to contact us for more information.

Information on Claystone's Category A Compost:

Claystone's compost has been laboratory tested.

The compost can be used as a soil amendment (mixing into the soil) or as a top dressing/mulch (spread compost on top of the soil where it will be incorporated over time). This includes for flower beds, vegetable gardens, lawns, for mulching around trees, and for tree planting.

Compost is not a replacement for soil but should be considered an additive.
