

# Village of Holden 2025 Municipal Election Candidates Information

#### **Time Commitment**

As a member of Council, you will face demands on your time. In addition to regular meetings, you will be expected to attend special meetings, sit on committees and attend various public meetings and functions.

#### Term of Office

Councillors serve a four-year term.

#### **Candidate Training**

There are three dates available for pre-election candidate training. The dates are either September 2, 3, and  $4^{th}$ , 2025. These are booked for 6 to 8 pm on each day at various locations within Beaver County.

#### **Councillor Orientation (mandatory)**

Is scheduled for October 29th, 2025. This is an all-day event.

#### **Election Day**

Election day is Monday, October 20, 2025. Polls will open at 10:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

#### Nominations

The Nomination period runs from January 1, 2025 through to September 22, 2025, with the deadline to submit nomination papers being 12:00 noon on September 22, 2025.

Nomination packages can be picked up from the Village of Holden Office or from Returning Officer Christine Mackay.

Prior to Nomination Day, you must book an appointment with the Returning Officer Christine Mackay at 780 -688-3812 to submit your completed nomination form.

## Notice to the General Public of the Village of Holden – Proposed Borrowing Bylaw No. 1-2025

The purpose of the Proposed Borrowing Bylaw No. 1-2025 is to meet the requirements of ATB in relation to the Village Operating Line of Credit that has be ongoing for a number of years. ATB requires that Council annually pass a borrowing bylaw for the line of credit. This Line of Credit covers the Village credit card and if necessary, operating cash flow. However, before the Line of Credit is used for Operating cash flow, Council would be notified by Administration and agree to the use.

A copy of the proposed bylaw may be viewed at the Village Office, 4810 – 50 Street, Holden, AB.

If any resident of Holden has concerns with the proposed bylaw, they may send a notice of their concerns to the Village Office, Box 357, Holden, AB TOB 2CO. The notice must outline the concern(s) that the individual has with the proposed bylaw and the reason why they are concerned.

#### **Heritage Resources Committee Update**

Did you know there is a Heritage Resources Committee in Holden? In 2010 the Village of Holden passed a by-law establishing this committee to promote the identification and protection of historic resources in the Village. The committee worked with the Province through the Municipal Heritage Partnership Program and using grant funds, matching money from the Village and in-kind contributions from the committee, a consultant was hired to do a survey and prepare the Village of Holden Heritage Inventory. The inventory includes a description of the property, the significant criteria, the context, the period of significance and the character defining elements for each of the 24 properties included. Once this was completed the committee worked with the consultant to prepare the Heritage Management Plan which establishes the process that must be followed to attain designation as a Municipal Heritage Resource. Once this plan was completed the Committee tested the process outlined in the plan to see if it was manageable by going through the process of having the old Village of Holden Garage designated. The designation was successful and we now have a total of four registered Municipal Historic Resources in the Village. They are the Old Village Garage, the Holden Museum, the Lutheran Church building that is now the Gallery and the Holden Cenotaph. A plaque was installed on each of these buildings and structures stating the designation and the date. Once the Municipal Historic Resource designation is completed the site is nominated by the Heritage Resources Committee for inclusion on the Alberta Register of Historic Places https://hermis.alberta.ca/arhp/. Once listed on this register, the property owner is eligible to submit an application to the province for Historic Resource Conservation funding through the Heritage Preservation Partnership Program of the Alberta Historical Resources Foundation https://www.alberta.ca/listing-historic-resources.aspx.

Does your property have Heritage value and would you like to have it designated as a Municipal Heritage Resource? If so, please contact our committee by talking to CAO Rosemary Offrey at the Village Office to get more information and to start the process. Remember that designations can't happen unless they are requested by the property owner. The Heritage Resources Committee can help the property owner with the process.

The current Committee members most of whom have been on the committee since its inception are Christine Mackay, President, Peggy Nahirniak, Vice President, Susan Tymchak, Dave Maruszeczka, Village of Holden Council representative Tyler Beckett and Secretary Rosemary Offrey, the Village CAO.

We would be happy to welcome new committee members so please let us know if you are interested.




