What is a Land Use Bylaw?

All municipalities in Alberta are required to have a Land Use Bylaw. This bylaw is the primary tool used to regulate land use and development, and allows the Village to issue development permits.

Why do we update the Land Use Bylaw?

To reach our goal of having a bylaw that is consistent, transparent and easy to understand, we want to review the existing bylaw to identify what's working and what's not.

What is the public's role in this project?

Public participation is an important part of this project. In the first phase, we'll ask residents to share their thoughts on land use needs, concerns, and ideas for future engagement.

The first public participation event is expected in **Fall 2025**.
