HOLDEN 2026 BUDGET & TAX INFORMATION

Do You Know...

- The 2026 Consolidate Budget is \$2,252,525. Local tax revenue is \$528,318. The remaining funds to balance the 2026 Budget comes from other sources such as provincial grants, Claystone Waste dividends, and shared services with Beaver County.
- Municipalities must collect Alberta School Foundation taxes, as per the province.
- Municipalities must support the Seniors Foundations tax, as per the province.
- Municipalities must pay a part of the cost of RCMP services each year.
- Property Assessments are provided by a third party and they must abide by provincial guidelines.

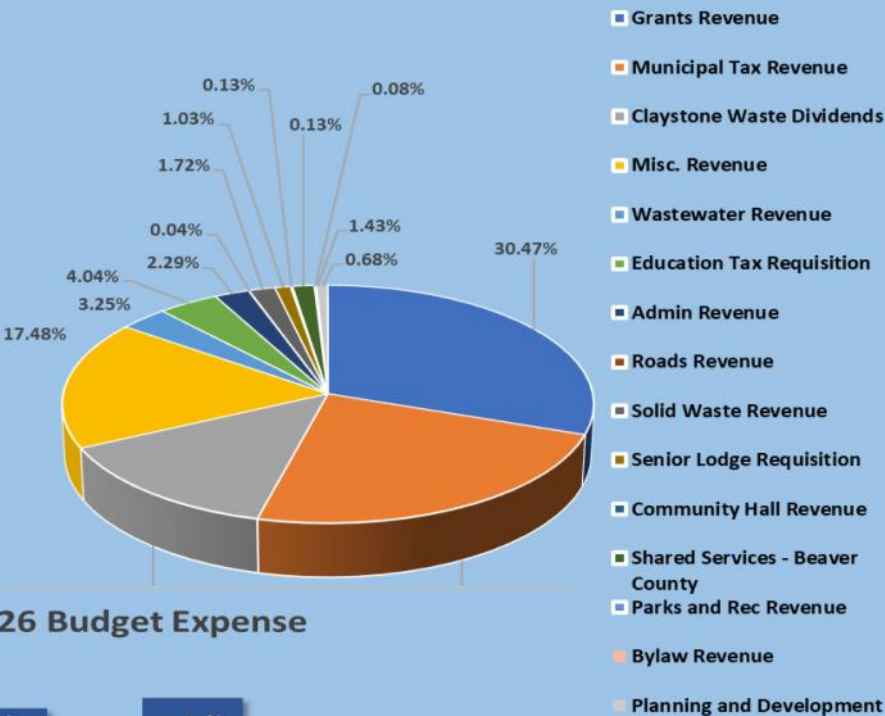
Dates to Remember...

- August 28, 2026 Deadline for Assessment Appeals.
- September 8, 2026 Property Taxes are due.
- September 9, 2026 first penalty applied to current taxes.
- October 9, 2026 second penalty applied to current taxes.
- January 1, 2027 second penalty applied to outstanding taxes.

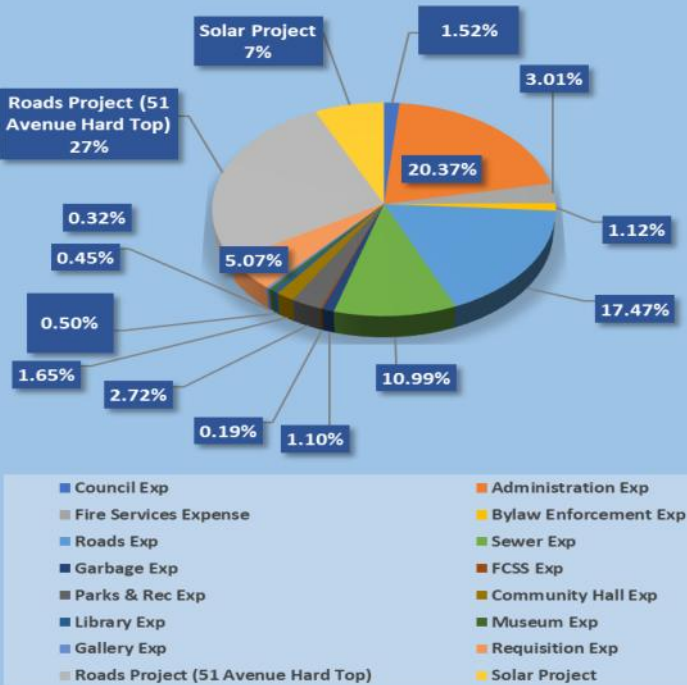

Regarding the Proposed Village of Holden Land Use Bylaw No. 2-2026

The Village of Holden wish to repeal the existing Land Use Bylaw No. 3-2013 by adopting the revised Village of Holden Land Use Bylaw No. 2-2026.

The Land Use Bylaw is Council's direction to Administration on how they wish land development to proceed within the Village. It lays out the rules for Administration to follow.

A copy of the proposed bylaw may be viewed at the Village Office, 4810 – 50 Street, Holden, AB.

The Village has held two Open Houses to gather public feedback regarding the revised Land use Bylaw.

Any resident of Holden has concerns with the proposed bylaw, may send a notice of their concerns to the Village Office, Box 357, Holden, AB T0B 2C0 by July 13, 2026 at 3 pm.

The notice must outline the concern(s) that the individual has with the proposed bylaw and the rationale for the concern. It should also state whether or not the individual wishes to speak at the Public Hearing for this bylaw.

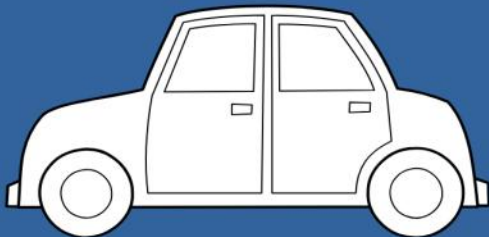
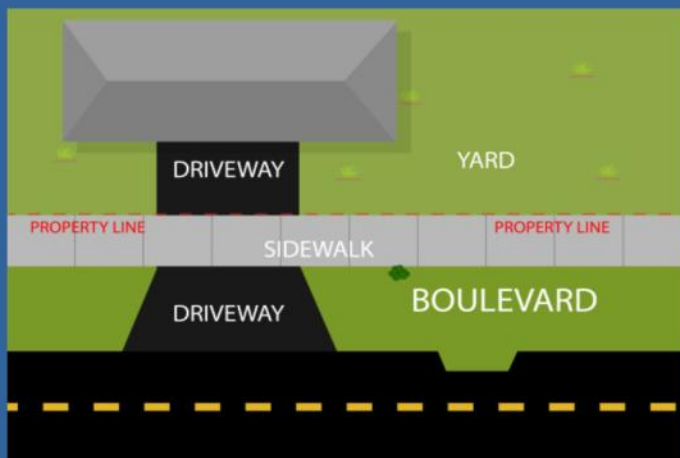
